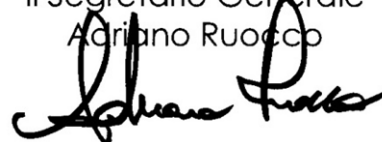
Oggetto: *Ranking competizioni femminili EHF stagione agonistica 2026/27.*

Dear Handball Friends,

We would like to inform you that the EXEC decided in its Meeting last Tuesday (21 October 2025), that there are no changes for the upcoming season for any EHF Club Competitions for Women. This includes the EHF Place distribution/ranking list well.

The EHF Place distribution/ranking list for all EHF Club Competitions Men will follow after the ExeC Meeting in December 2025.

Therefore, please find enclosed the EHF Place distribution/ranking list for EHF club competitions season **2026/27 for WOMEN**.

The EHF Place distribution/ranking list defines the distribution of places for each Federation to the different Women's EHF Club Competitions.

The EHF Place distribution/ranking list contains points for the performance of the clubs over a period of three seasons leaving out the most recent season. The ranking list for the 2026/27 season therefore is based on the results of the seasons 2024/25, 2023/24 and 2022/23.

The ranking is calculated strictly and independently from each other. That means that three different ranking lists are calculated (one only for the EHF Champions League, one only for the EHF European League and one only for the EHF European Cup). That means each competition has its own EHF Place distribution/ranking list. This three-part ranking system properly reflects the performance of each federation in the respective competition.

The total number of teams of a Federation in EHF club competitions remains the same. That means Federations ranked 1 and 2 of the EHF European League have in total 5 teams and all remaining Federations have in total 4 teams except Federations which did not participate in any EHF club competition in the last 3 calculated seasons – these Federations have 3 places in total in the EHF club competitions.
